



Guerin College Preparatory High School/Triton College Dual Credit Program – FAQ

Which courses are eligible for Triton College credit?

Only the Guerin Prep courses listed on the Triton College Dual Credit Program sheet are potentially eligible for dual credit.

How is my Triton College credit reported to other colleges?

Triton College will create an official transcript that you can have sent to other colleges of your choice.

How much of the Triton College credit will be accepted at other colleges?

That is up to the policies and discretion of the colleges to which you are sending your transcripts. Neither Guerin College Prep nor Triton College can determine how much credit is accepted by other colleges.

What is the cost of the program?

Students will be charged a \$20.00 fee per college credit hour. Credit hours range from 3-5 credits per semester/year. Triton College determines the credit hours for each course.

Am I required to attend Triton College?

You are not required to attend Triton College to earn the college credit. Courses are taught at Guerin College Prep by Guerin College Prep faculty as part of the Guerin College Prep academic program. You are not required to attend Triton College to have your Triton transcript sent to other colleges. If you choose to attend Triton College, the dual credit courses are part of your academic record at Triton College.

Can I have only some of my Triton College courses sent to colleges?

No. When you choose to send your Triton College transcript to another college, Triton will send the entire transcript to that college. The time to choose the courses in which you want to earn dual credit is now. Triton will enroll you only in the courses that you list on your Dual Credit Enrollment Application.

How do I enroll in the program?

You must qualify for the course(s) and enroll as a Guerin College Prep student who is seeking dual credit through Triton College. To enroll in Triton dual credit courses, you must complete the Dual Credit Enrollment Application

Be sure to list all potential courses in which you will be enrolled during the 2017-18 school year and for which you would like Triton College credit. **A parent or guardian must sign the application to allow the high school to share test scores and other information required for admission to the Triton College Dual Credit Program.**

Are there qualifications for the program?

To qualify for **any dual credit course**, you must have ACT or SAT scores or Triton Proficiency exam scores that meet Triton's entrance requirements. Specific scores may be needed for certain courses. If you have not taken an ACT or SAT exam or if your scores do not meet Triton entrance requirements, you must take the Triton proficiency exam in reading, writing, and math at Triton College.

If I am planning to take the AP exam why should I enroll in the Triton program?

Many of our dual credit courses also offer an AP exam whose scores can be reported to colleges, but we offer the Triton College Dual Credit Program as an additional opportunity for students to earn college credit in case you choose not to take the AP exam, you do not score well on the exam, or no AP exam is offered. Students who register for the dual credit program and earn a "C" or above in the Guerin College Prep course will earn Triton College credit for the equivalent course offered by Triton.
